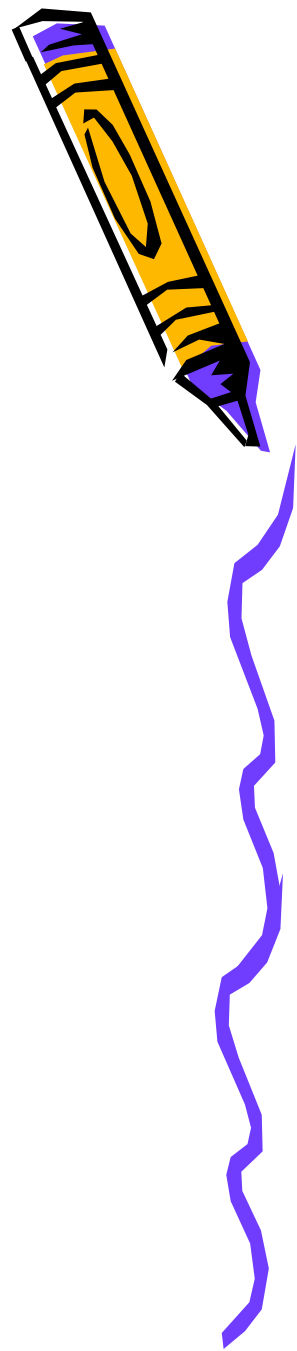

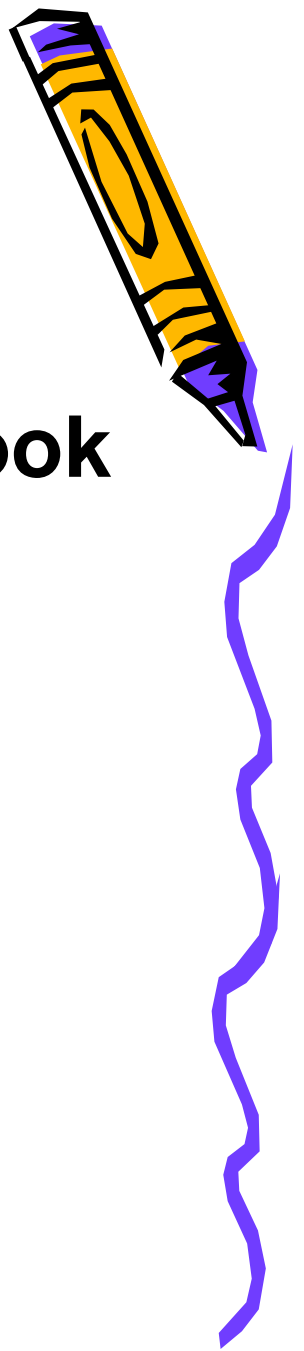
Pre-AP Biology Tests

- What you put into this course is what you will get out of it. It takes commitment.



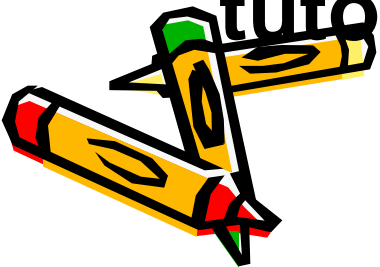
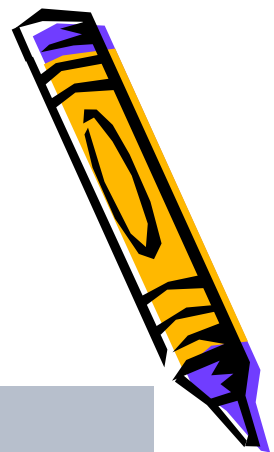
Helpful Hints
